

Boundaries and Safety at Brownsea



Blue – In boats, on boat ramps, on pontoons, standing on the sand and when in the water.

- **PFD's must be worn by all members of Scouts Australia** - youth members AND leaders when in these areas, even if they are not participating in boating activities.
- Please ensure your youth members have been correctly fitted by a Unit Leader or Brownsea leader – please ask for help if you are unsure.

Purple – Shared driveway, boat ramp, boat shed, and storage shed.

- The driveway and boat ramp are shared by a number of organisations in the area, cars and boats may be moving around this area through the day.
- The **boat shed and storage areas** contain expensive equipment which could be easily broken, as well as uneven ground and hazards which could be a **risk to unsupervised youth members**.
- Joeys and Cubs should be **supervised at ALL times** in these areas.
- Leaders and youth members should **only enter purple areas if asked or instructed by a member of the Brownsea team**.

Green – Parade Ground

- The **parade ground is a free area** for the Joeys and Cub scouts to be during lunch and free time.
- Joeys must be supervised by Unit leaders during breaktimes.

Orange – Bunkrooms, dining area kitchen area and verandahs.

- During day activities, these areas are out of bounds for Joey scouts.
- Joeys who are staying the night at Brownsea may need to access the bunkrooms to change clothing – In this case joeys will need to be supervised by unit leaders at all time.

Red – Carpark

- The **carpark area is out of bounds** for youth members – except when arriving and leaving.
- Please ensure your youth members are not playing on or crossing the chain blocking off the carpark area.
- The staircase in the carpark is also not for use by Joey and Cub Scouts.
